

Current Alzheimer's Studies/Research:

- CLARITY-AD: Leqembi administered twice a month to eliminate amyloid plaque and slow progression in mild cognitive impairment and early Alzheimer's Disease.

- ENVISION: Medicare authorized trial of Aduhelm given IV once a month to eliminate amyloid plaque in Alzheimer's Disease and slow progression.

- HOPE: Jointly sponsored by MIT, Emory & University of Tennessee, this is a medical device that is worn an hour a day from the comfort of your home to boost electrical activity in the brain and slow Alzheimer's Disease Progression. See hopestudyforad.com.

- New IDEAS: A study to investigate the value of amyloid PET scans in diagnosing and treating suspected Alzheimer's Disease.

- EVOKE: Evaluation of an oral diabetes drug to slow progression of Alzheimer's Disease.
